It is essential for users of iamproperty CRM ensure compliance with GDPR regulations to help effectively manage client communications.

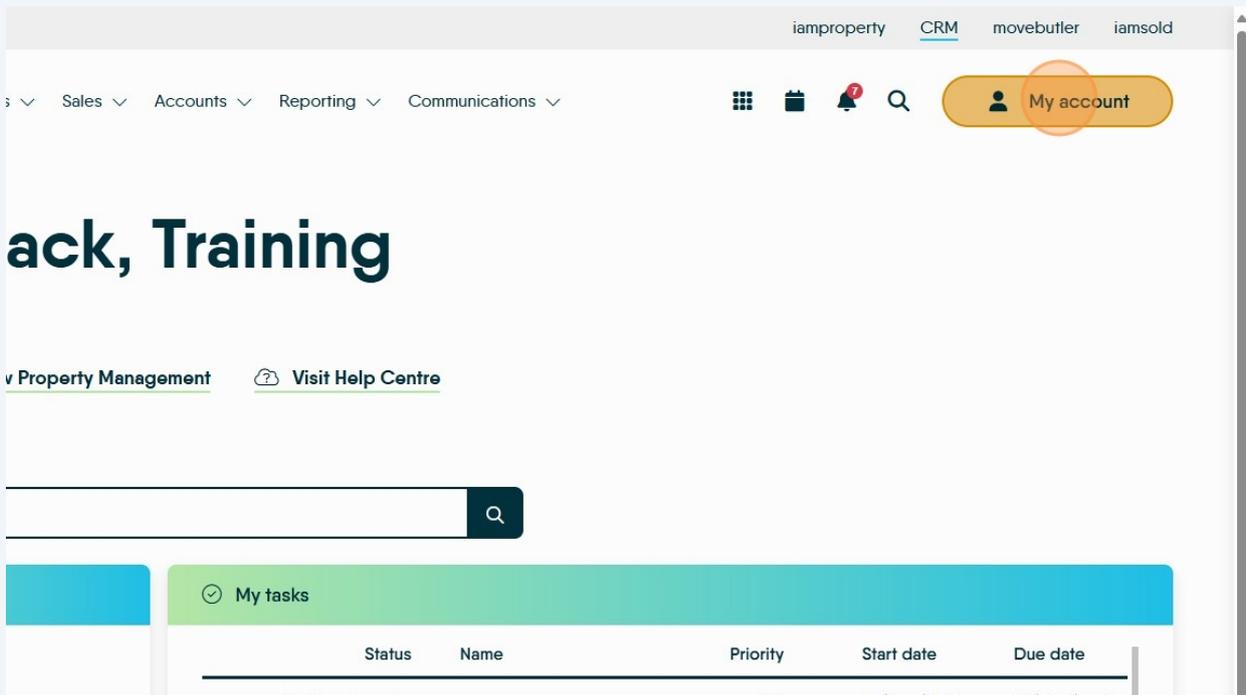

**1** Navigate to <https://crm.iamproperty.com/MyDay>

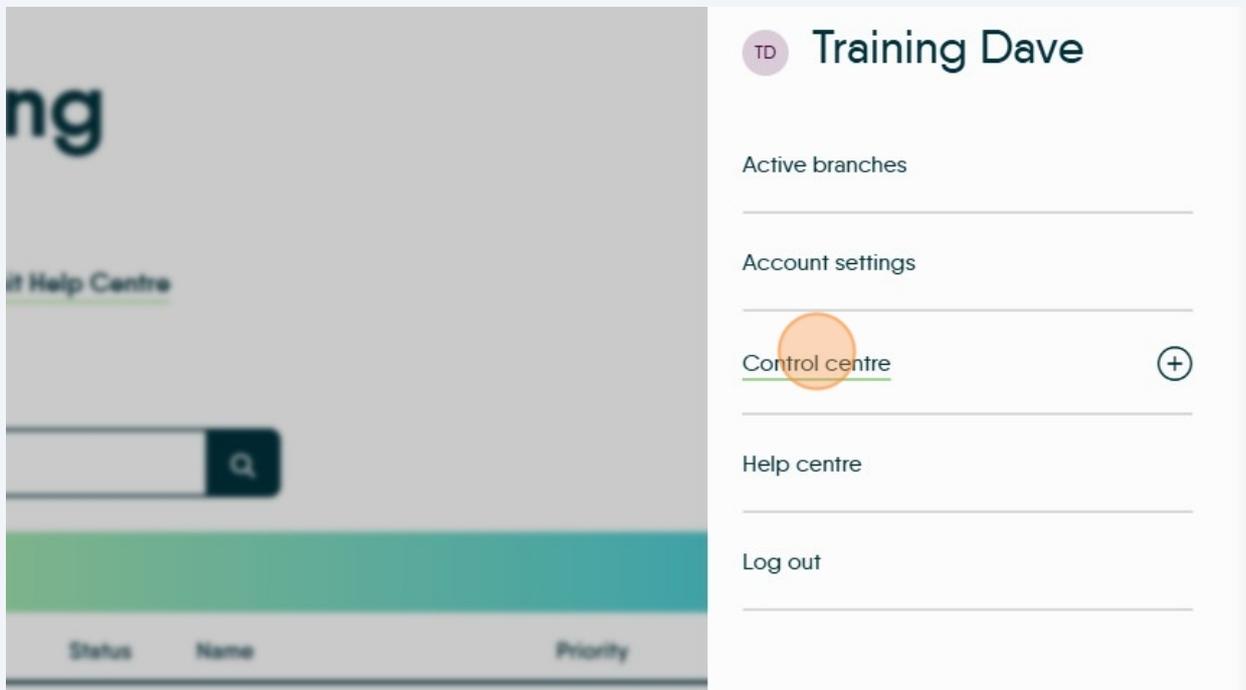
 Tip! This process will allow you to set a default GDPR setting for all new 'person' records added to the CRM after you have enabled to GDPR.

iamproperty CRM will not stop you sending messages from CRM if the GDPR is not set, however the icons will be greyed out. Some features on CRM e.g. Matching properties/applicants will not work correctly without GDPR being setup and 'Marketing' allowed.

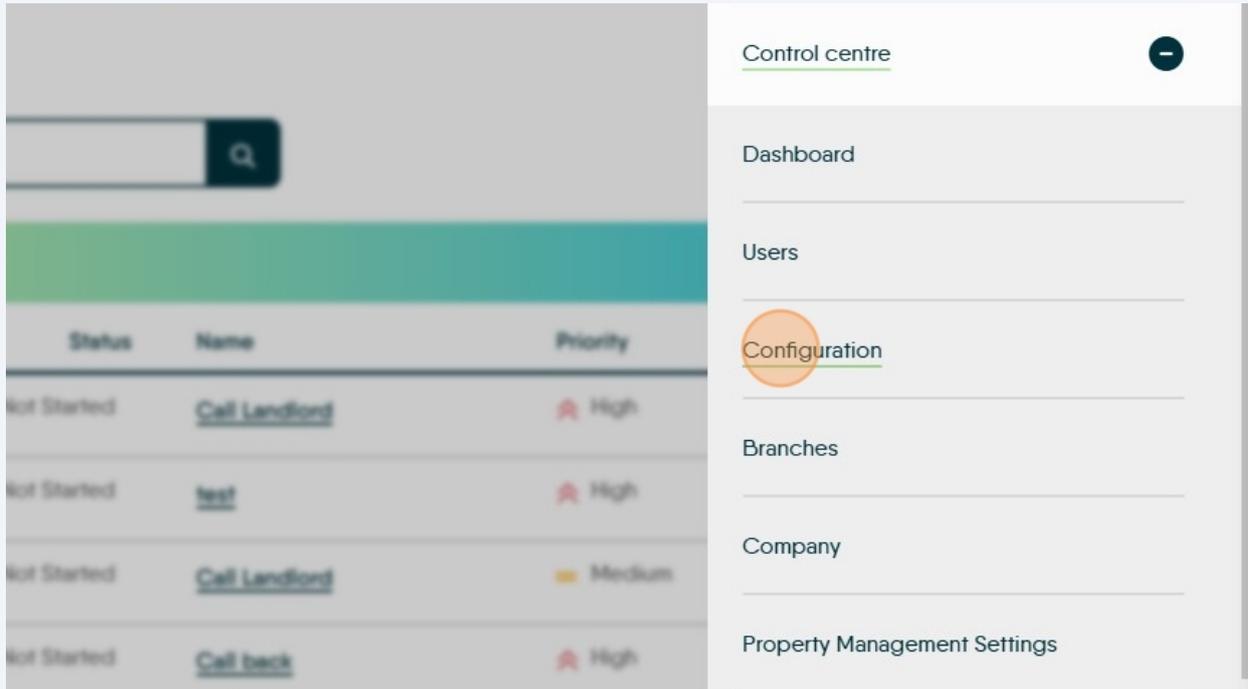

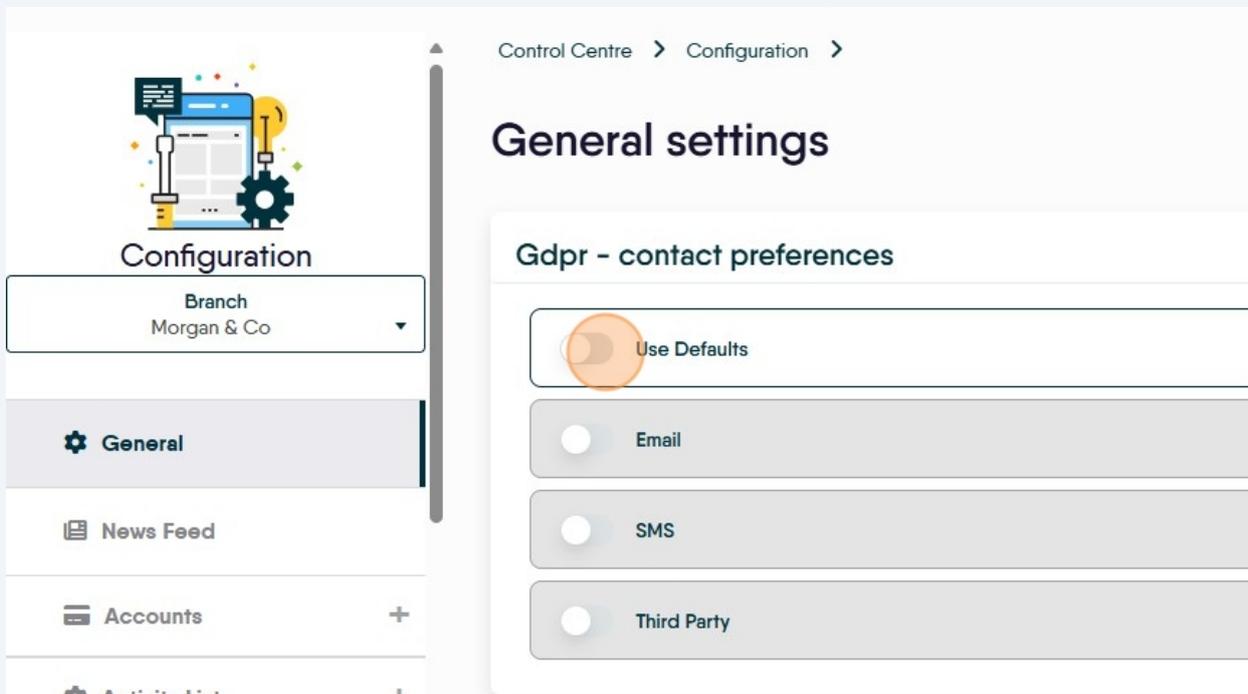

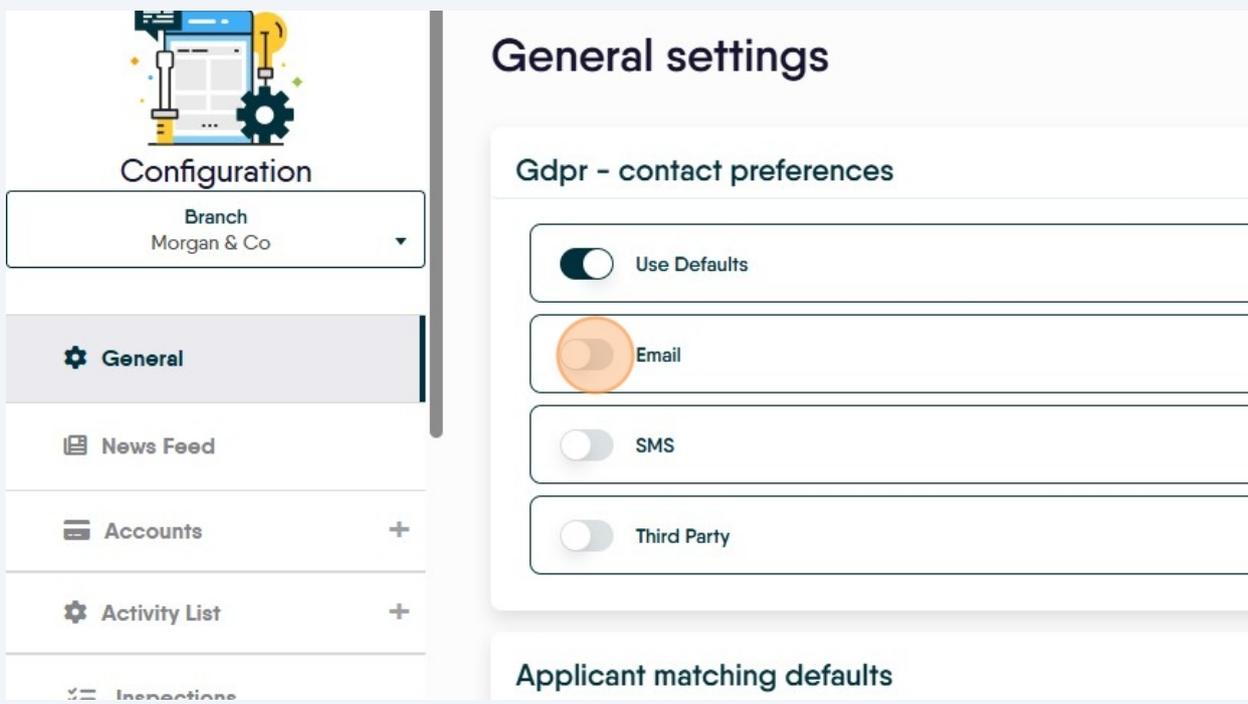
