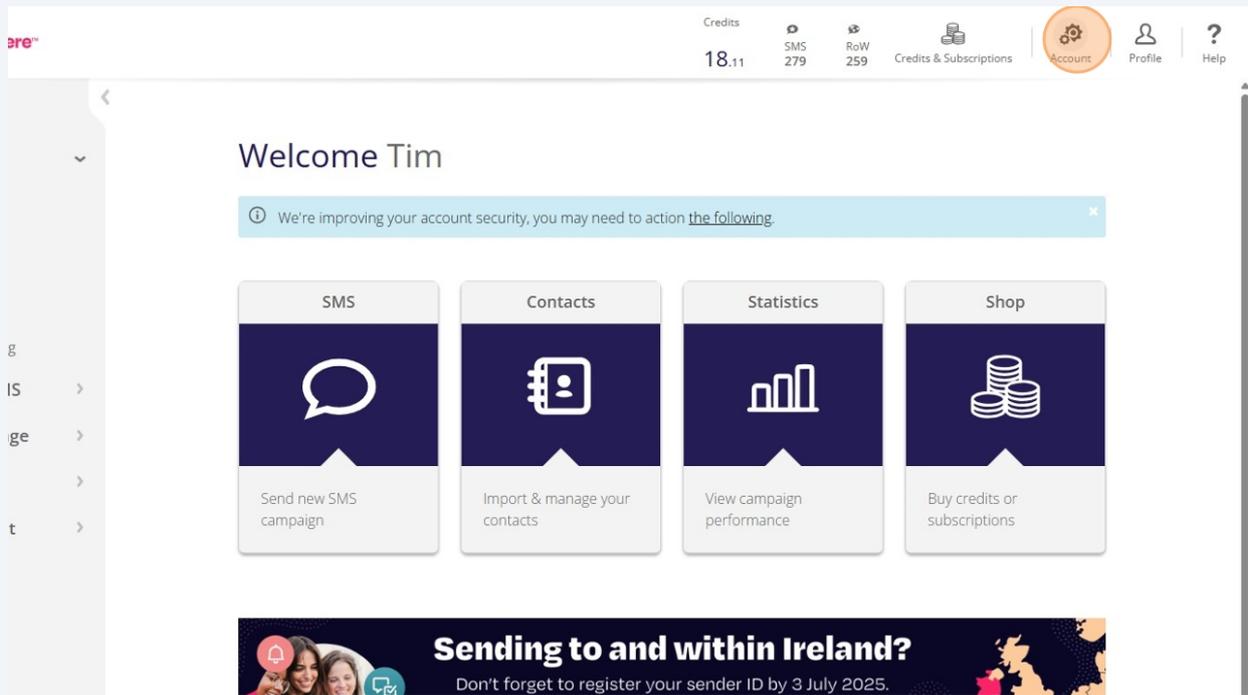


How to find your TextAnywhere email/API password

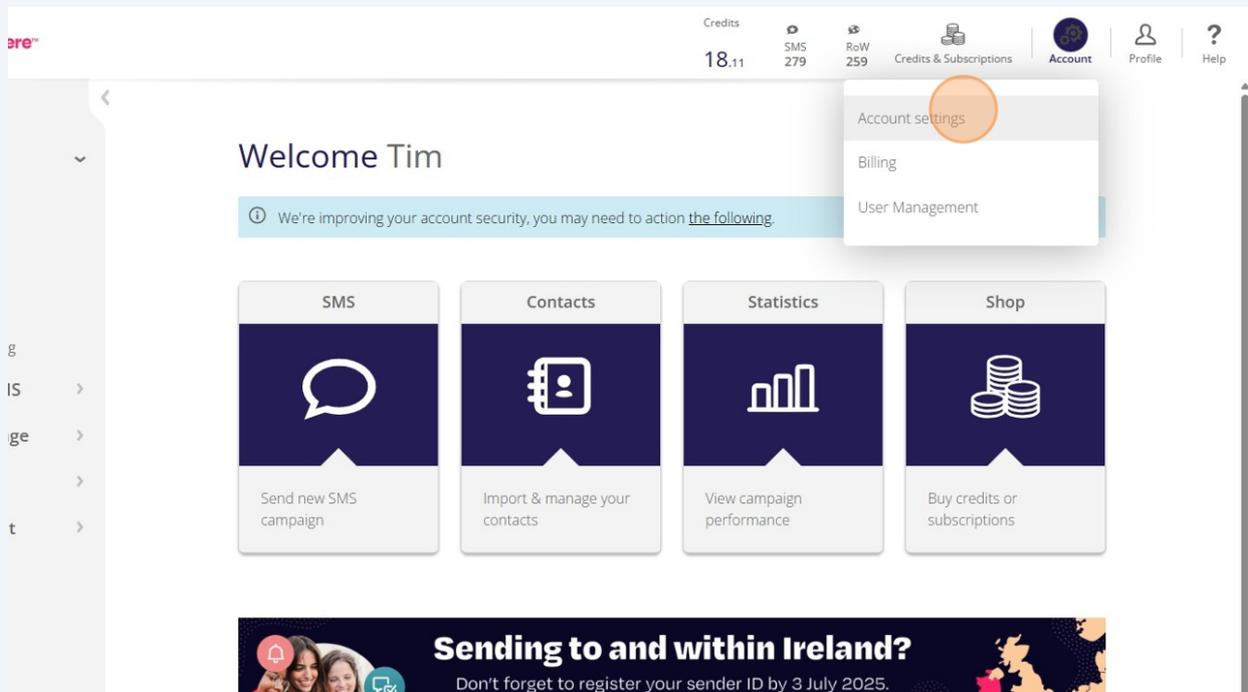
1 Log in to your TextAnywhere account
